Spring 2021 "Accelerated" Construction Trades/Apprenticeship Program Learning Formats



The ABC - Northern Ohio Chapter will be offering Construction Craft / Apprenticeship Education Programs in an expanded variety of formats beginning in January 2021. These formats have been approved for the delivery of apprenticeship training related-instruction while maintaining COVID-19 Safety measure practices

All instruction is based on the nationally recognized NCCER curricula, and the online learning program, **NCCER Connect**. Instructors complete training on how to use the curricula with most having journeyman+ experience in the trade. In all cases, the NCCER curricula will be supplemented with videos, instructor demonstrations and other media to enhance the learning experience.

The Spring 2021 "Accelerated" Construction Craft

The ABC Spring Accelerated, Trade-Specific Training Program is designed to meet the needs of both contractors and their workforce. These two-night-a-week classes gives students the first level of NCCER construction craft training in: Carpentry, Plumbing, Electrical or HVAC and OSHA 10-Hour Training in just four months. This training, being held at the Broadview Heights Training Center, is ideal for:

- Employers looking to quickly get recent hires up to speed with trade-specific theory and basic skills, while not losing valuable time on the job-site.
- Employers looking to broaden the skills of their workforce by giving employees cross-training in another trade.
- Individuals looking to get top training by experienced professionals that will help them be prepared for the 2021 Construction Season.

Tuition for this training is just \$1,390 for ABC Members and unemployed students, and \$1,720 for students from Non-Member Companies. Those wishing to continue to take craft training can move to Level 2 in the Fall of 2021 and complete the Core Curriculum at that time. (Additional tuition will be required for Core).

These Spring classes fill up fast. Don't miss out on this cost-effective opportunity to jump start your workforce's skills, or to get the fundamental skills you personally need to join the construction industry in 2021. Classes start the week of March 29th. The Registration Deadline is March 19th.
