ABC members can use TechCred funding for construction craft training

Lt. Governor Jon Husted, who serves as Director of the Governor's Office of Workforce Transformation, announced the results of the October round of TechCred, which will provide the opportunity for 246 Ohio companies to upskill their workforce.

The most recent TechCred application period closed at the end of October. During this round, 246 Ohio employers were approved for funding, resulting in Ohio employees earning up to 3,164 technology-focused credentials. This round marks a milestone as funding for the program has been approved for over 15,000 credentials.

In August, the TechCred program exceeded 10,000 tech-focused credentials, fulfilling a commitment made by Governor DeWine and Lt. Governor Husted to fund 10,000 technology-focused credentials each year.

Since the program's start, a total of 966 Ohio employers have been approved for funding, supporting the earning of 15,105 tech-focused credentials by Ohio employees.

The seventh TechCred application period opens on Monday, January 4th and closes on January 29th at 3:00 p.m.

Businesses with employees who have completed their TechCred training are reminded to submit proof of credential completion to receive reimbursement at TechCred.Ohio.gov

Winter 2021 Construction Trades/Apprenticeship Program Learning Formats



The ABC - Northern Ohio Chapter will be offering Construction Craft / Apprenticeship Education Programs in an expanded variety of formats beginning in January 2021. These formats have been approved for the delivery of apprenticeship training related-instruction while maintaining COVID-19 Safety measure practices

All instruction is based on the nationally recognized NCCER curricula, and the online learning program, **NCCER Connect**. Instructors complete training on how to use the curricula with most having journeyman+ experience in the trade. In all cases, the NCCER curricula will be supplemented with videos, instructor demonstrations and other media to enhance the learning experience.

The Winter 2021 Construction Craft learning format options are:

Blended Learning - held two evenings per week - 8 hrs. total

Instructor- led online learning with periodic classroom and hands-on training, reviews and testing. In person training will be held every second or third week at one of ABC's Training Centers. Most, if not all, traditional students will participate in this form of learning.

Online Learning

Instructor- led online learning only with written and performance testing completed every four to six weeks at one of ABC's Training Centers. This format will initially be offered for the Electrical Trade. Additional trades will be added during the school year.

Correspondence Learning

This format is offered primarily for students on a job assignment that takes them out-of-town, making it difficult to attend classes in person for two or more weeks. Instructor-led reviews and training with testing will be completed when returning to class.

Traditional- held two evenings per week - 8 hrs. total

Classroom Learning – When permitted, classes will be offered in the traditional instructor-led classroom setting at an ABC Learning Center.

In-house Training

Learning will take place at the employer's company with experienced journey persons serving as the instructors. Instructor training in the use of the NCCER curricula is required. Contact the ABC Workforce Development and Apprenticeship Department for more details.
